VINYL DECAL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The surface and air temperature should be at least 10°C. Clean the surface well.

Decide on final placement of the decal. Make pencil lines or put masking tape on the surface, to mark the exact location.

The decal is sandwiched between it's backing and it's application tape. Place the decal facing up on a hard surface. Rub the application tape to ensure it is sticking well to the decal.

Turn the decal over and slowly remove the backing. If any parts of the decal stick to the backing, put the backing back down and press to re-attach it to the application tape.

Align the application tape with your marks on the surface, and apply it, inside first, moving outward. Rub over the decal to ensure good adhesion.

Peel off the application tape. If bubbles appear: press them out to the edge with a fingernail. Bubbles away from an edge can be punctured with a pin and flattened.

Cold climate tip for windows: apply the decal to the inside of the window to protect it from damage by your frost scraper. (The decal must be applied to the outside if the glass is darkened.)
